


Aim and Objectives

The **IENE 9** project aims to enable teachers and trainers of theory and practice to enhance their skills regarding LGBT+ issues and to develop a culturally competent and compassionate LGBT+ curriculum in health and social care.

Objectives:

- To develop teaching and learning tools to be used by health and social care educators/trainers in order to improve their own knowledge and confidence in teaching LGBT+ issues;
- To develop the knowledge of health and social care professionals on how to support LGBT+ patients and meet their health care needs;
- To prepare and pilot a Massive Open Online Course (MOOC).



The project Outputs

The main outputs of the project will be:

1. A report on the need’s assessment of teachers/trainers and learners in health and social care;
2. A compendium of local, national and European legislations/guidelines and best practice on teaching LGBT+ issues in health and social care education;
3. A training Model and Curriculum;
4. Teaching/learning tools (available in all partners languages: EN, IT, ES, RO, DE, DA, EL);
5. A Massive Open Online Course (MOOC).

**Assessing the
needs**

The first output we are working on is a “Assessing the needs of teachers/trainers for LGBT+ training”.

1. To understand whether LGBT+ issues are adequately covered in health and social care curricula;
2. Identification of teachers' and health and social care workers' LGBT+ learning needs and cross cultural/country comparison.

For this output a needs assessment report will be produced and available on the project website.

Output no. 2

**Mapping of
educational
policies and
guidelines**

The second output is an “Internet mapping and systematic documentation of educational policies and guidelines as well as legislation at European and national level on LGBT+ rights and education”.

As part of this output we will produce a catalog, easy to navigate with information about European and national legislations/guidance/policies for LGBT+. This will be translated in all participating countries languages (EN, IT, ES, RO, DE, DA, EL).
